**Suvarnabhumi Airport launches Hi-Speed Wireless Internet Service**

Mr. Nirandra Theeranartsin, the General Manager of Suvarnabhumi Airport, disclosed that Airports of Thailand Public Company Limited (AOT) has joined with Milcom Systems Company Limited to launch WLANNet - Hi-Speed Wireless Internet Service (Wi-Fi), with connection speed of 1 Mbps, at Suvarnabhumi Airport.

Mr. Nirandra explained that there are 2 types of Wi-Fi service; one is available for passengers FREE of charge, which may be used in the Concourses and the Baggage Claim areas of the Passenger Terminal building. Passengers may obtain Username/Password at any of the Airport Information Counters (in the Concourses).

He also added that anyone wishing to use the Wi-Fi service in any other areas of the building, may purchase Internet Card online (at [www.wlannet.net](http://www.wlannet.net)) or at Milcom's retail agents, for example, the News & Books stores and any of the Duty Free shops. The rate for the Wi-Fi service is BHT 250 / hour, and the Internet Card is available to purchase for 1, 2 or 3 hours.
