Suvarnabhumi Airport joins hand with KASIKORNBANK offering an alternative payment method for its business partners

Mr. Serirat Prasutanond, the President of Airports of Thailand Public Company Limited (AOT), disclosed that Suvarnabhumi Airport would offer a new and more convenient method of payment for the airport's business partners from the 1st December 2009.

AOT has partnered with KASIKORNBANK in offering internet payment (e-payment) service through the bank's Electronic Invoice Presentment & Payment (eIPP) system. This will be a more convenient alternative to the existing methods of paying at the cashier counter at AOT office, Suvarnabhumi Airport or through transfer of payment into AOT bank account. E-payment service allows the business partners to make payment at their convenience, 24-hrs a day; saving cost, time, paperwork and manpower. The advance technological eIPP system of the bank guarantees security and precision of payment and the business partners can also check for invoice and payments online in real-time.

Mr. Serirat also added, as Suvarnabhumi Airport is a major international airport of Thailand, with around 270 business partners – including airlines, service providers and retailers, it will be the first airport to offer this convenient method to enhance customer satisfaction for its partners. Furthermore, AOT will offer e-payment at all of its other airports, if the business partners at Suvarnabhumi Airport are satisfied with this new service.
