‘The Magnificent Mekong River and Loi Krathong Festival’ exhibitions at Suvarnabhumi Airport

Mr. Nirandra Theeranartsin, the General Manager of Suvarnabhumi Airport, disclosed that the Airport, joined together with Tourism Authority of Thailand (TAT), to organize ‘The Magnificent Mekong River and Loi Krathong Festival’ exhibitions in 5 areas of the Passenger Terminal building of Suvarnabhumi Airport. The exhibitions are on display from the 1st October to the 4th November 2009.

Mr. Nirandra also explained that the main exhibition is displayed by Entrance 5, on the 4th Floor (Departure Hall) of the Passenger Terminal building, where there are various activities arranged for passengers, for example, demonstrations of how to make a ‘krathong’ (a water lamp, traditionally, made from banana leaves).

Furthermore, passengers can participate by placing a krathong into a replica pond by the main display. The other 4 exhibitions around the Passenger Terminal building are:

- 1) Magnificent Mekong River, located in the International Departure Hall (4th Floor), on the walkway towards Concourse C.
- 2) Loi Krathong Festival, located in the International Departure Hall (4th Floor), on the walkway towards Concourse E.
- 3) End of Buddhist Lent, located on the 2nd Floor, in the Baggage Claim area, by conveyor belts 12-14.
- 4) Loi Krathong Festival and Loi Krathong Sai Festival, located on the 2nd Floor, in the Baggage Claim area, by conveyor belts 19-20.

In addition, leaflets explaining each festivities and souvenirs are available for passengers at all 5 locations.
