**Training on how to help prevent luggage theft for Baggage Sorting Area staff at Suvarnabhumi Airport**

Suvarnabhumi Airport and Rachatewa Police Station organized a training session for Baggage Sorting Area Staff to help prevent luggage theft.

Flying Officer Narongchai Tanadchangsang, Deputy General Manager of Suvarnabhumi Airport (Operations Line), Airports of Thailand Public Company Limited (AOT), disclosed that Suvarnabhumi Airport and Rachatewa Police Station jointly held a training session for 180 baggage handling staff on the 17th December 2009. The participants are handling staff, for example, from Thai Airways International Public Company Limited and Bangkok Flight Services, and security staff from Chubb Aviation Security Limited and Loxley-ITCS Consortium.

Flg.Off. Narongchai explained that the purpose of the training is to educate and inform operational staff in the Baggage Sorting Area on how to help prevent luggage theft and be the ears-and-eyes of the organization. Any information should be reported to the Suvarnabhumi Airport security staff or to the police promptly and accurately. Flg.Off. Narongchai concluded that the training session will provide greater assurance of security for passengers and airport users.
